


OPTICAL GEL GUIDELINE FOR WOODPECKERS




NESTING HOLES


- 1. For empty nests only. Any eggs must hatch and leave nest before treating.
- 2. Remove vacant nesting materials.
- 3. Spray Dissolve-It inside hole and 12" surrounding areas. Soak for 20 minutes.
- 4. Repeat with diluted bleach while area is damp let dry.
- 5. Once outer wall is dry, attach disks 1" from opening according to spacing guide.
- 6. Wait 7-10 days before repairing the hole. Use same disks after repair.
- 7. Leave for at least 90 days. Treat any new holes or activity immediately.

SOUNDING AREAS

- 1. Spray Dissolve-It where woodpeckers are sounding and soak for 20 minutes.
- 2. Rinse and wipe surface.
- 3. Repeat with diluted bleach while area is damp.
- 4. Once dry, attach disks 6" center-to-center from affected areas.
- 5. Leave for at least 90 days and treat new activity immediately.







- 2. Add 12 discs per area w/6" spacing.
- 3. Each sounding area should be 12" x 24" approx..
- 4. Leave disks at least 90 days.
